

Ukrainian Attacks Kill 2 in Belgorod, Damage Apartments Outside Moscow

Ukrainian drones damaged two apartment buildings and an industrial plant in the Moscow region and killed at least two people in the southwestern Belgorod region, officials said Thursday.

Moscow region Governor Andrei Vorobyov [said](#) 56 Ukrainian drones were destroyed overnight.

He published photos of two residential buildings where fires broke out, saying they were located in the towns of Pavlovsky Posad and Kubinka.

Independent reports [said](#) the Kubinka apartment building is located 5 kilometers (around 3 miles) from the Russian military's Kubinka Air Base.

Vorobyov said a drone crashed onto the grounds of an unidentified industrial plant in the

village of Bolshoye Bunkovo, located north of Pavlovsky Posad.

Moscow Mayor Sergei Sobyenin [said](#) air defenses had destroyed more than 100 drones flying toward the capital since Wednesday evening.

Elsewhere, in the Belgorod region, authorities said one civilian [was killed](#) in Ukrainian attacks over the past 24 hours. They [said](#) later on Thursday that an attack on a bus killed a passenger.

Russia's Defense Ministry [said](#) it intercepted 416 Ukrainian drones across Russia and annexed Crimea between Wednesday night and Thursday morning.

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
